



Flight & airport arrival information: FSD Salta

A note on purchasing flights:

Participants are responsible for making their own flight arrangements to and from the program site. Participants are also solely responsible for any airfare or other travel fees, charges, expenses or penalties, that might result from any cancellation of or change in the Participant's program, whether the Participant cancels the program or it is cancelled or altered by FSD. With this in mind, it would be prudent to consider purchasing flight insurance when buying your ticket abroad.

Important:

Most international flights into Argentina fly into Buenos Aires, arriving at the **Ministro Pistarini de Ezeiza (EZE) International Airport**. From there, interns are responsible for arranging and financing their transport to Salta. Internal flights from Buenos Aires to Salta leave from **Jorge Newbury (AEP) Aeroparque** in Buenos Aires and arrive at **Martin Miguel de Güemes (SLA) Aeroparque**, in Salta. Direct transfers run constantly between the airports. Please Leave ample time between connecting flights to make this transfer, as the airports are at a distance from each other and bags must be rechecked.

All participants need to arrive at the specified airport by the designated time IF they wish to be picked up from the airport and escorted to the orientation site. The FSD program fee only covers travel costs for those being picked up at the group arrival time. ***We ask that all participants try to arrive on the afternoon flight from Buenos Aires.*** Those arriving separately, outside of the scheduled pick up time, will be responsible for their own cost of travel to the orientation destination as well as any other costs incurred along the way. You will be contacted by FSD prior to your arrival with information about the group pick up from **Martin Miguel de Güemes (SLA) Aeroparque**.

Frequently asked questions (regarding airports and flights):

How far is the orientation site from the airport?

The Martin Miguel de Güemes (SLA) Aeroparque Salta is about half hour outside of downtown Salta.

If I cannot meet the group for the scheduled pickup how do I get to the orientation site?

There are shuttles as and taxis available from the airport, but it is important to contact your site team prior to your arrival so they can give you directions and other arrival information.

What time should I book my return flight?

Please keep in mind that your program will end on a Saturday. Morning flights departing from Salta are recommended to ensure ample time for the connection between airports in Buenos Aires.

Are there any other tips for arrival?

Please make sure to keep your site team's phone numbers on you at all times so if you are delayed or have any questions you can easily contact them.
